# STATUTORY DECLARATION

I, <sup>(a)</sup> Dirona Lohia Doriga of PO Box 18, KONE DOBU, National Capital District, do solemnly and <sup>(b)</sup> sincerely declare that,

- 1) The Kikori settlers came to settle at Paga Point (Paga Hill) sometimes in 1954, however, my father, Mr. Lohia Doriga had known before the settlers came that a WWII veteran, Mr. Mairi Nakaia was put to look after WWII relics at the Paga Hill area by an Australian, a colonel Cole Wilson.
- 2) The Geakone Clan, the clan who owned Konedobu and the rest of Port Moresby down town, knew about that arrangement. Naturally, the clan accepted the Kikori to settle following their biological relative, the late veteran soldier Mr. Mairi Nakaia. The first wave of Kikori settlers came to settle between 1963 and 1965.
- 3) When the late Mairi Nakaia died in 1970, my father, Lohia Doriga, called a meeting in which he thanked the late Mairi Nakaia and asked the settlers to continue taking care of the WWII relics.
- 4) My father and the Kikori settlers formed a committee made up of the following people from Kikori at that particular meeting: Messrs Daure Kisu, Adami Kero, Wakai Gauri, and Sukai Pae.
- 5) I was with my father and other members of the clan at that particular meeting.

And I make this solemn declaration by virtue of the Oaths, Affirmations and Statutory Declarations Act of 1962 consciously believing the statements contained therein to be true in every particular.

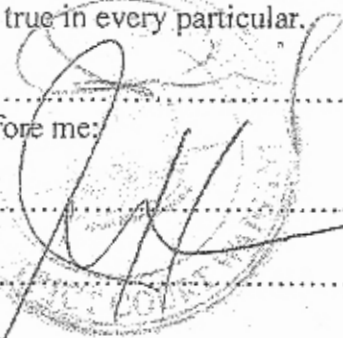

### STATUTORY DECLARATION

I, <sup>(a)</sup> Daure Kisu of PO Box 7270, BOROKO, National Capital District, do solemnly and sincerely declare that, <sup>(b)</sup>

1) The Kikori Settlers and I, following directions, followed our biological relative, Mr. Mairi Nakaia to settle at Paga Hill (or Paga Point). Mr. Mairi Nakaia was a veteran soldier during WWII. He fought alongside the Allied Troops.

(a) The first authorization was made by the Late Colonel Cole Wilson. Straight after the war, Veteran Soldier Mairi Nakaia was instructed to take care of the War Bunkers. He faithfully discharged his duties until his death in 1970.

(b) On 24 December 1964, the Kikori Settlers moved to Paga Point and settled on sea-reclaimed land. There are two generations born at Paga Point since the settlement.

2) In 1971, landowner and clan leader of the Geakone Clan, Mr. Lohia Doriga, officially called a meeting, and in that meeting, Mr. Lohia Doriga acknowledged and thanked the late Mairi Nakaia for the curatorial work on the war bunkers. Moreover, under his leadership of his clan - the Geakone clan -, and at the said meeting, the verbal agreement was reached that Messrs. Dauri Kisu, Adami Kero, Wakai Gauri and Sukai Pae, would continue to look after the WWII relics.

3) The verbal agreement was witnessed by both members of the Kikori Settlers, and members of the Geakone clan, who were present at the time. Clan leader Mr. Lohia Doriga's own son, Mr. Dirona Lohia Doriga, was present at the time.
